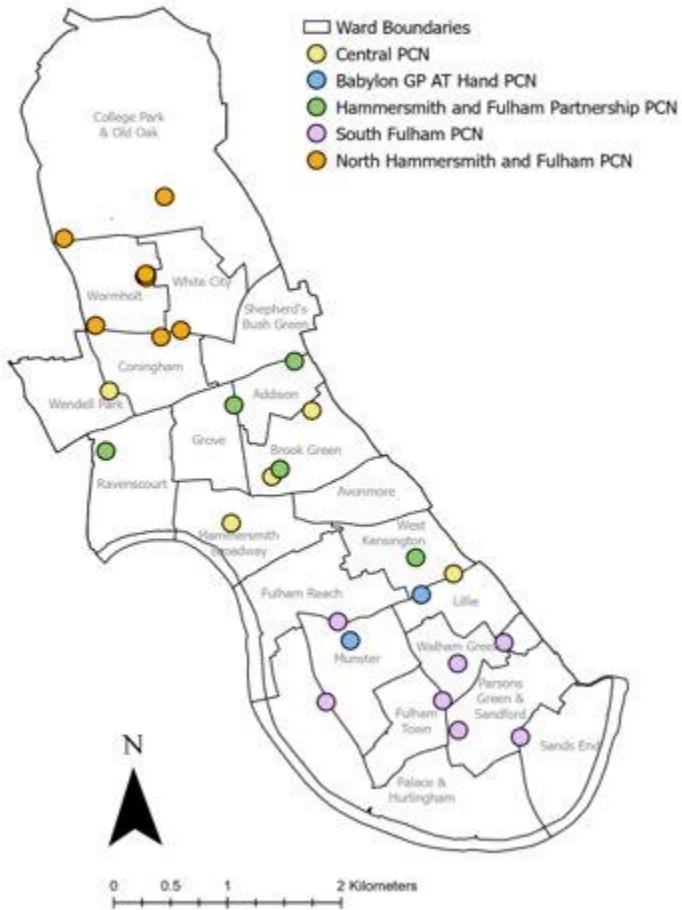

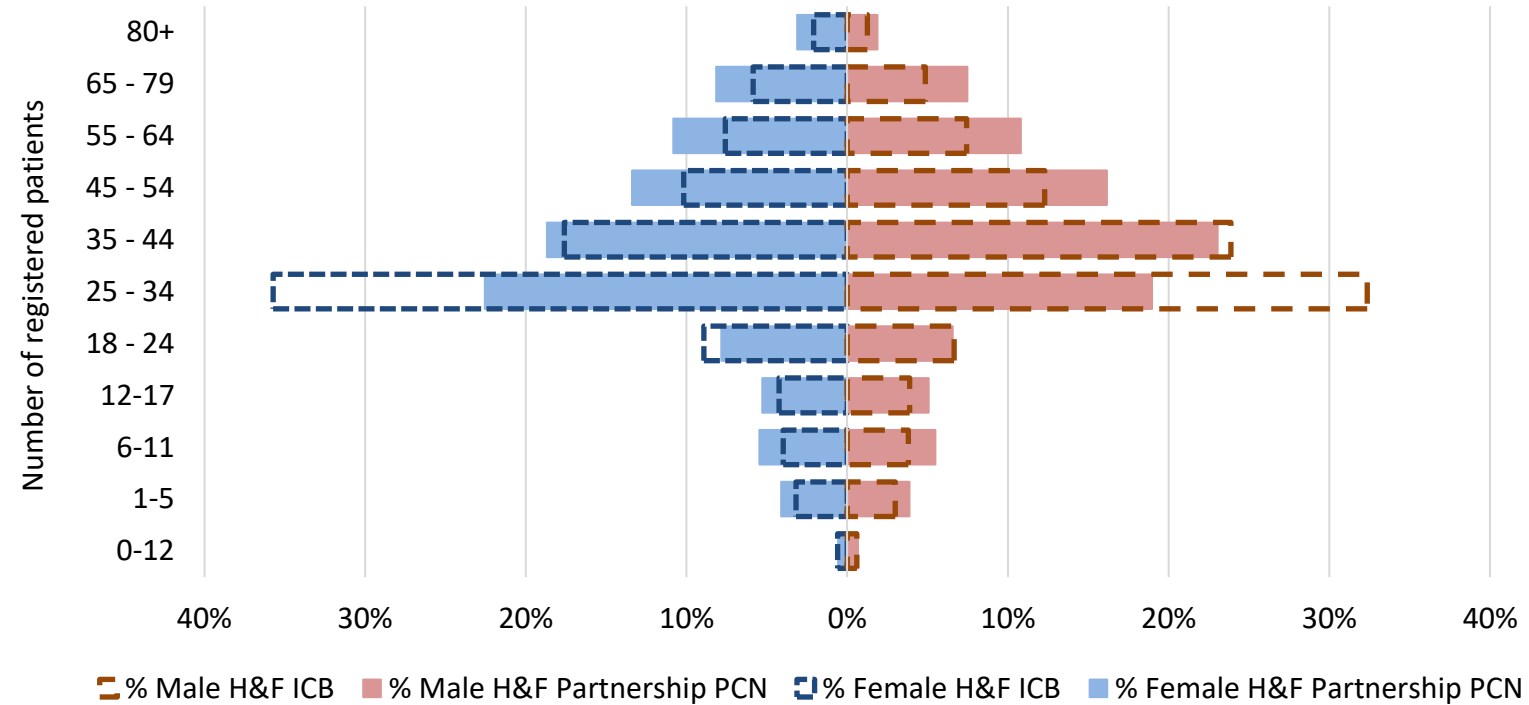

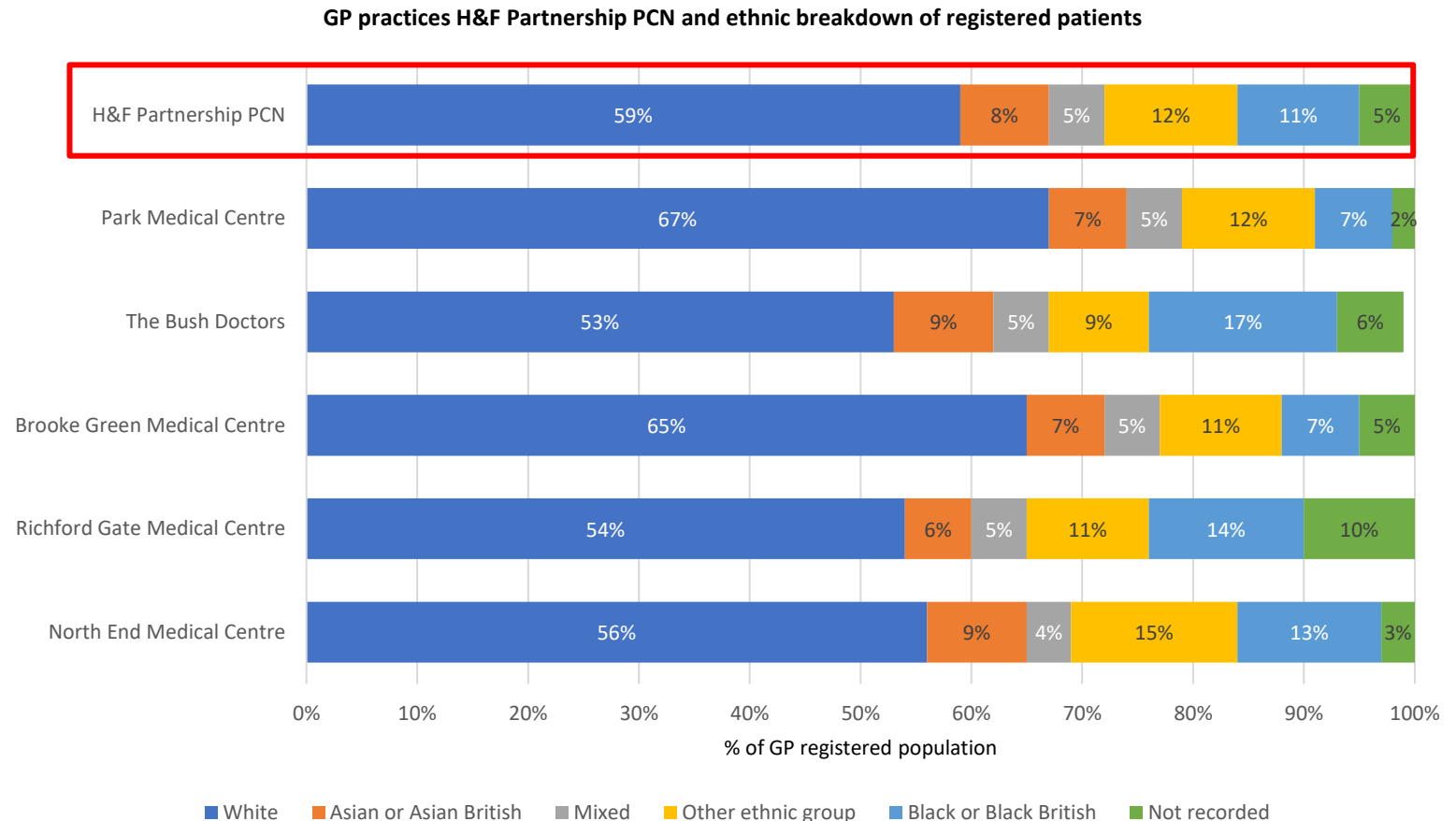


- Total of **69,956** registered at H&F Partnership PCN (October, 2023).
- The **modal age range is 25-34 years**.
- There is almost an equal split between male (50.1%) and female (49.9%) patients registered.
- Partnership PCN has a **larger older population above 45 years (except for males aged 35-44 years)** compared to the overall H&F ICB population.

Ethnicity Profile

Section 1: Demographics

- **59%** of the registered patients at H&F Hammersmith PCN are **“White”**.
- **36%** are from **ethnic minority group**.
- **There is a higher proportion of White (3.7%), Black (+3%) and Mixed (+0.4%) ethnicities** when compared to the overall H&F population.
- North End Medical Centre has the largest ethnic minority population (41%) compared to all other practices within H&F Partnership PCN.

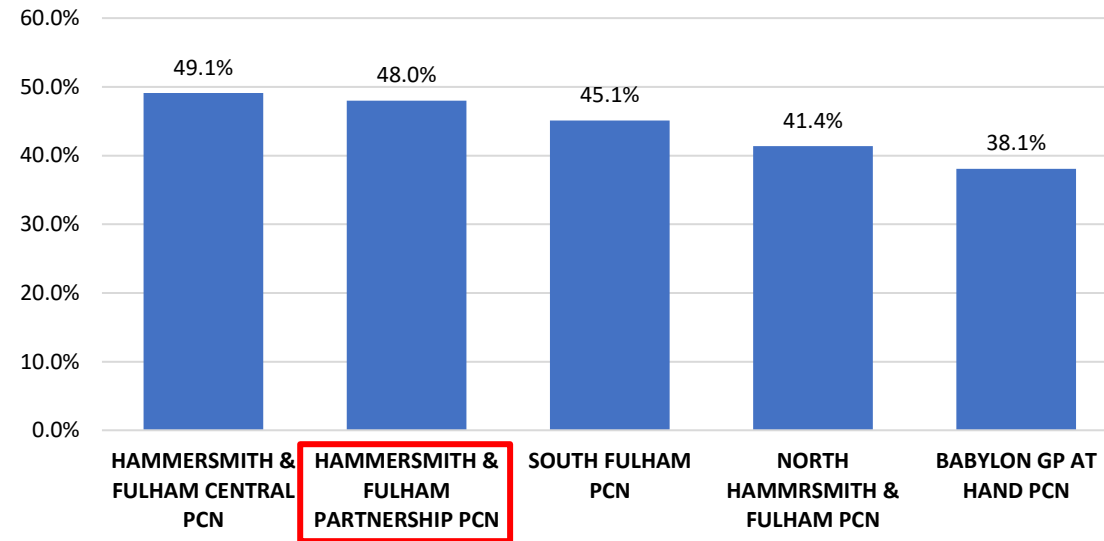

% with Long Term Health Conditions

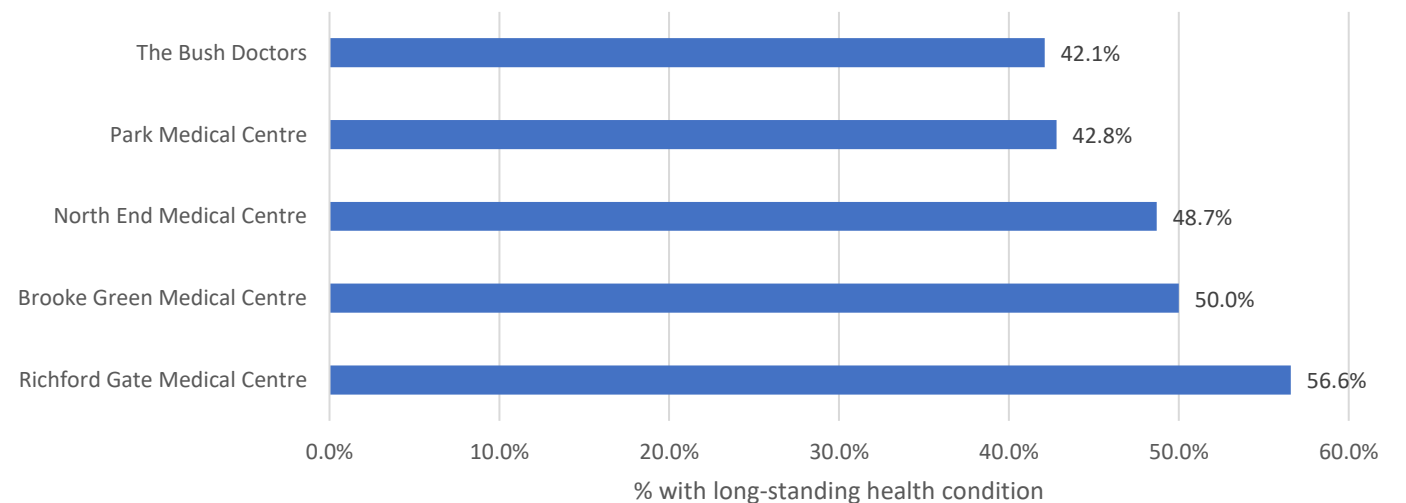
Section 2: Long-term Health Conditions

- The percentage of patients with long-standing health conditions in H&F Partnership PCN is 48.0%. This is the 2nd highest percentage amongst all PCNs in the borough.
- Within H&F Partnership PCN, **Richford Gate Medical Centre (56.6%)** has the highest percentage of patients with long-standing health conditions in 2022.

% of patients with long term health conditions by GP practice, in H&F Partnership PCN in 2022

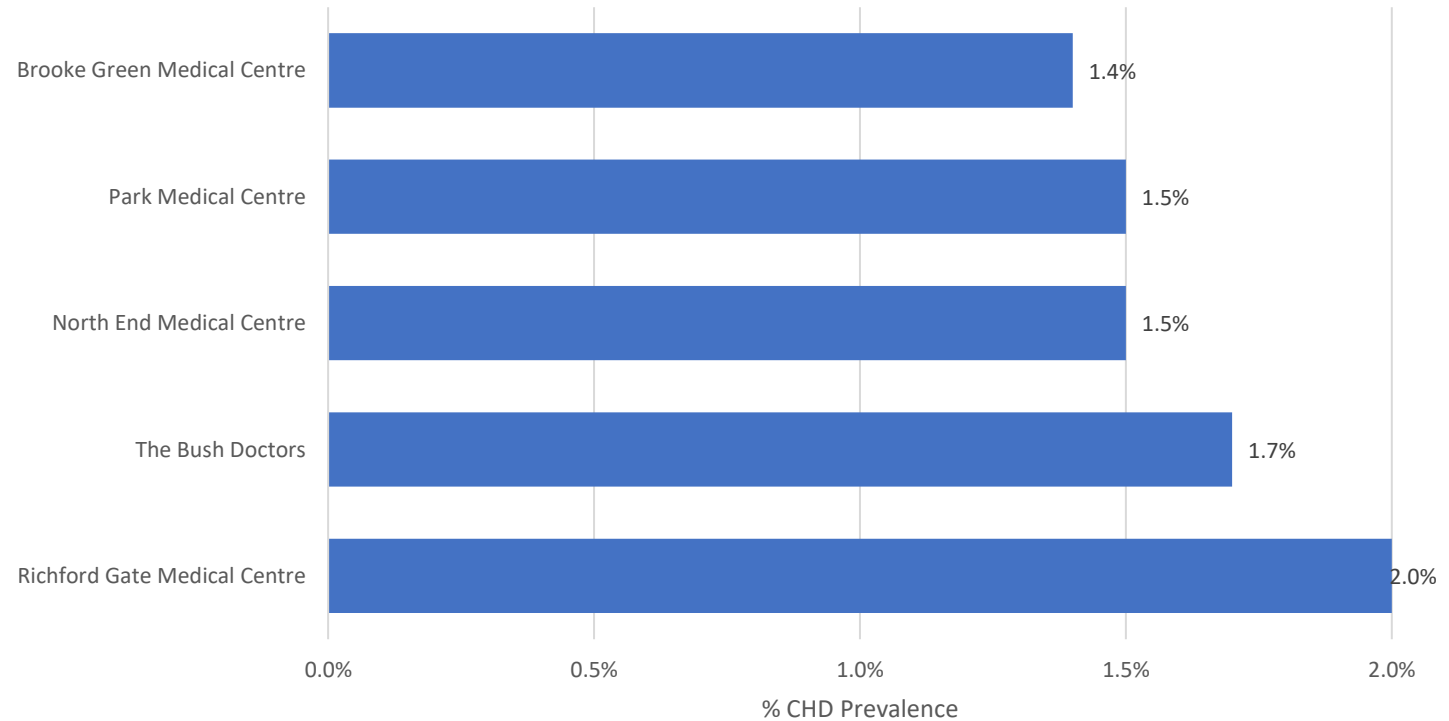


Coronary Heart Disease

CHD Prevalence by GP practice, in H&F Partnership PCN in 2021/22

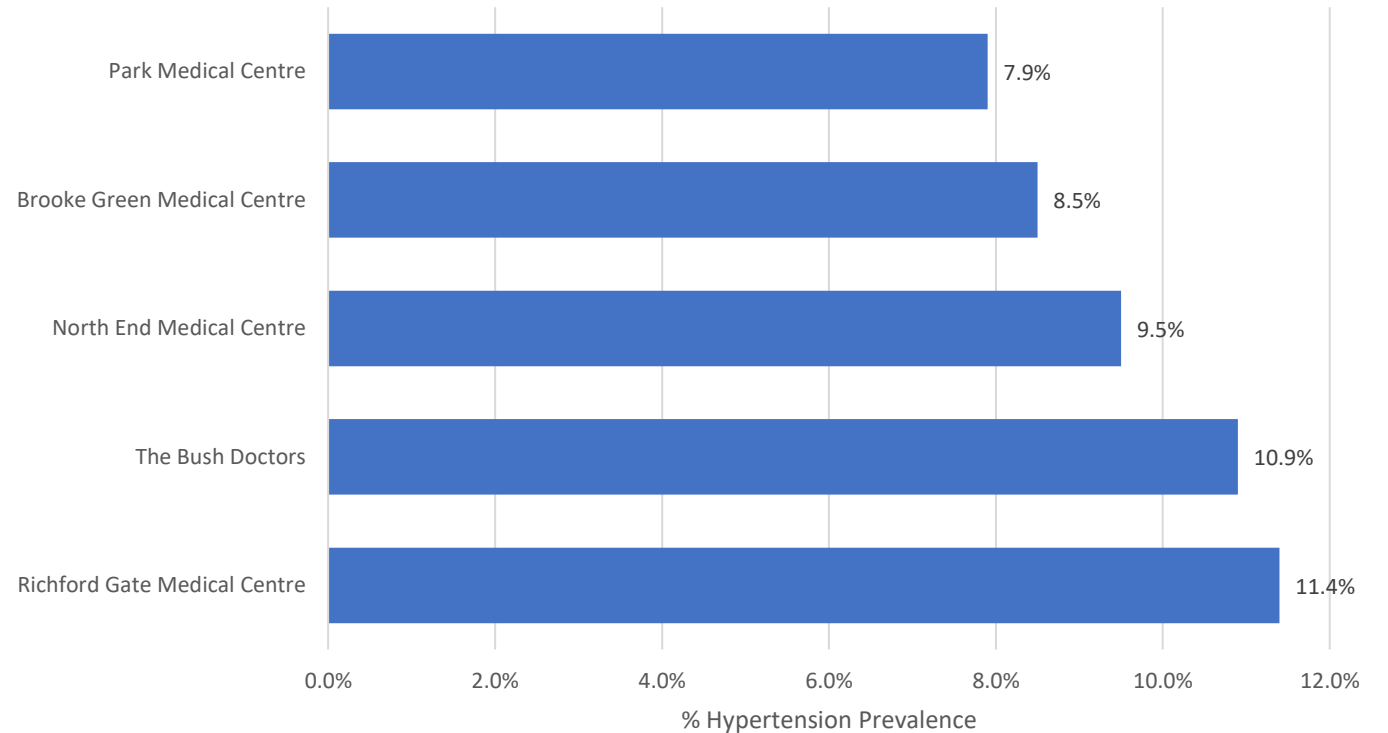


Hypertension

- Within H&F Partnership PCN, **Richford Gate Medical Centre** has the **highest** Hypertension prevalence of **11.4%**.

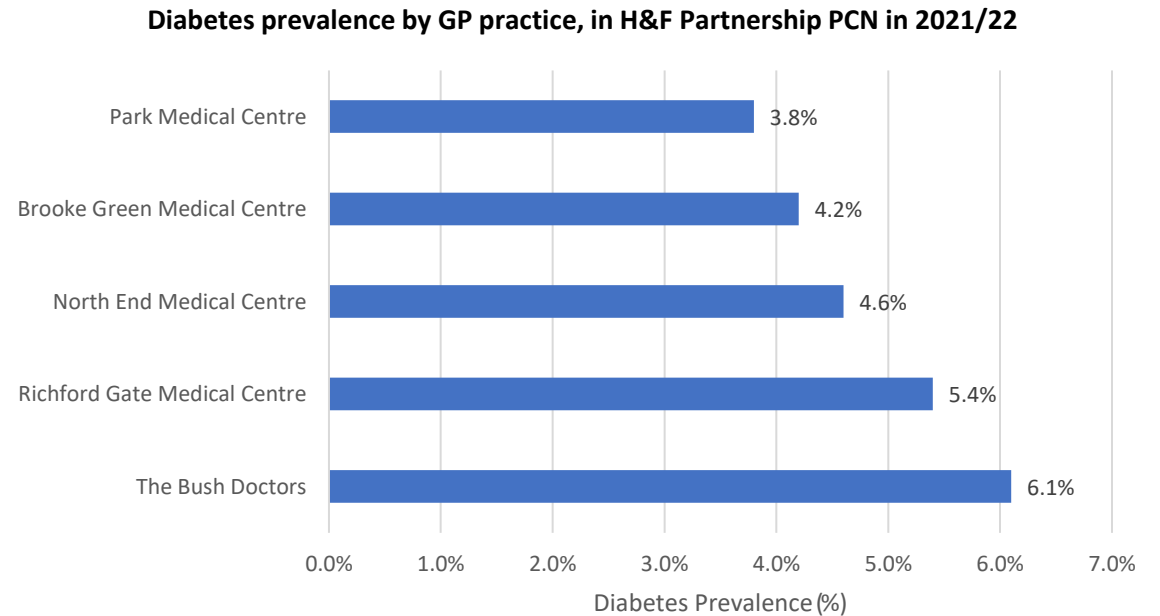
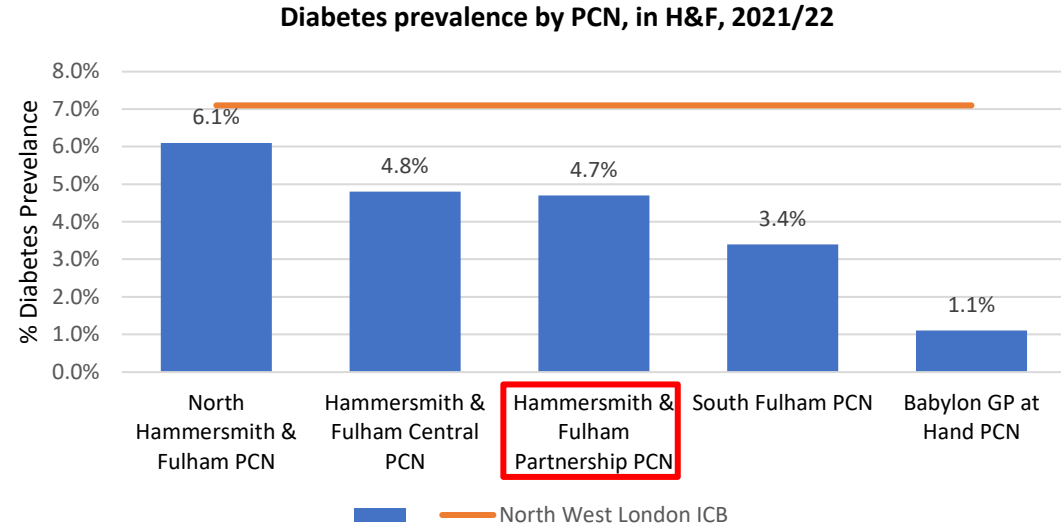
Hypertension Prevalence by GP practice, in H&F Partnership PCN in 2021/22



Diabetes

Section 2: Long-term Health Conditions

- The prevalence of diabetes amongst patients registered with H&F Partnership PCN is **4.7%**. This is **lower than the NWL ICB figure of 7.1%**.
- Within H&F Partnership PCN, The Bush Doctors has the **highest** Diabetes prevalence of **6.1%**.

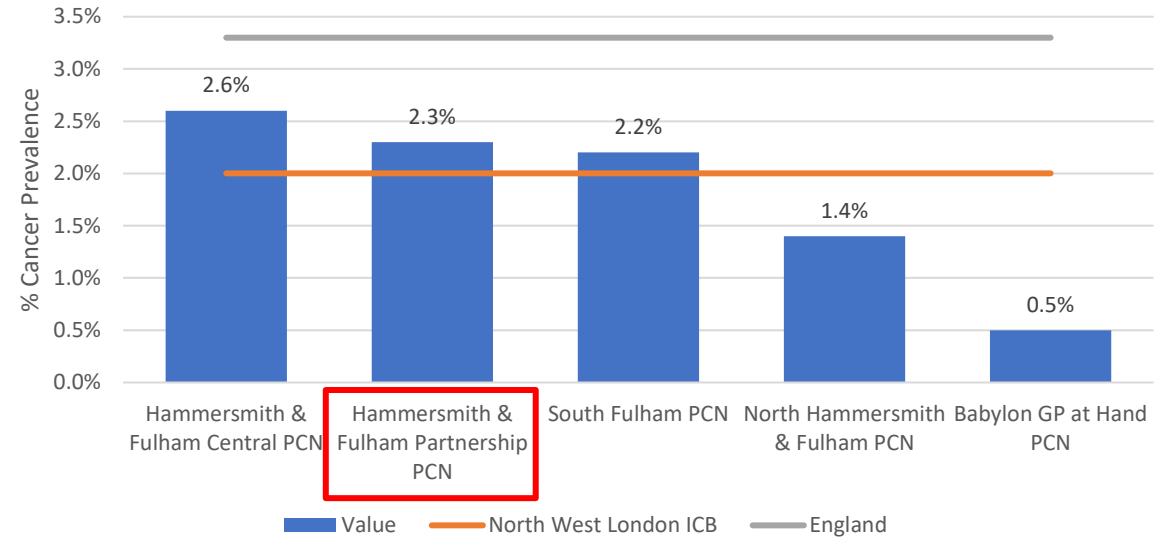


Cancer

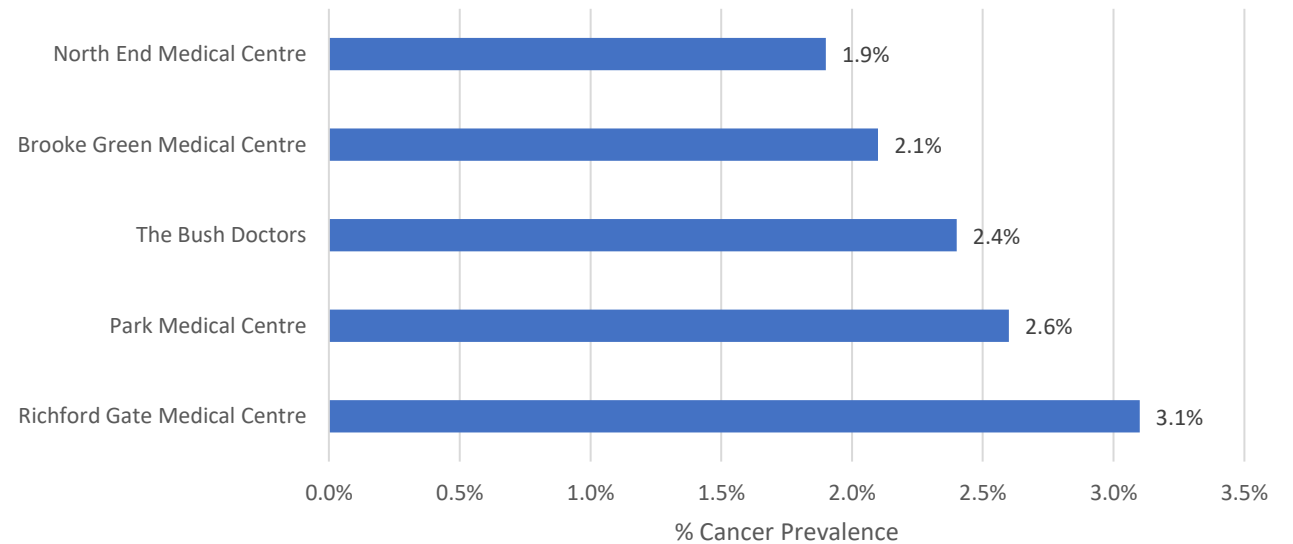
Section 2: Long-term Health Conditions

- The prevalence of cancer amongst patients registered with H&F Partnership PCN is **2.3%**. This is the **2nd highest proportion among all PCNs in H&F and higher than the NWL ICB figure (2%)**.
- Within H&F Partnership PCN, **Richford Gate Medical Centre** has the **highest** Cancer prevalence of **3.1%**.

Cancer prevalence by GP practice, in H&F Partnership PCN in 2021/22

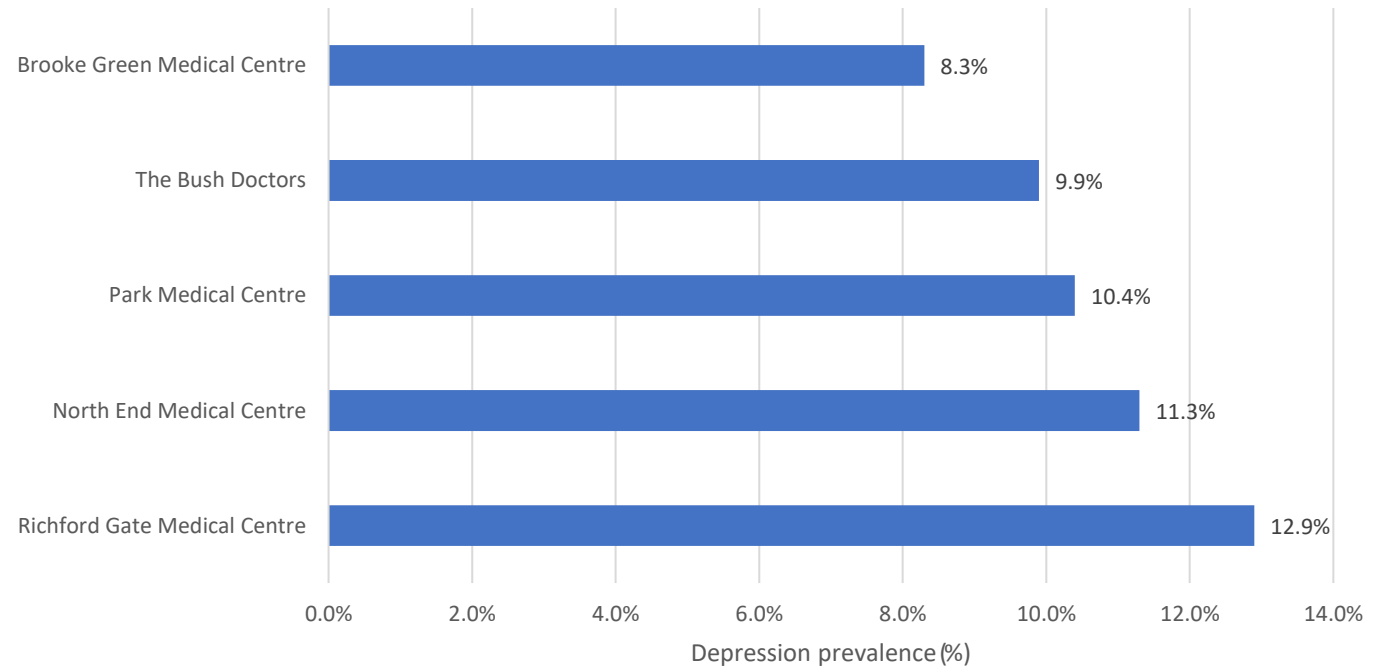


Mental Health

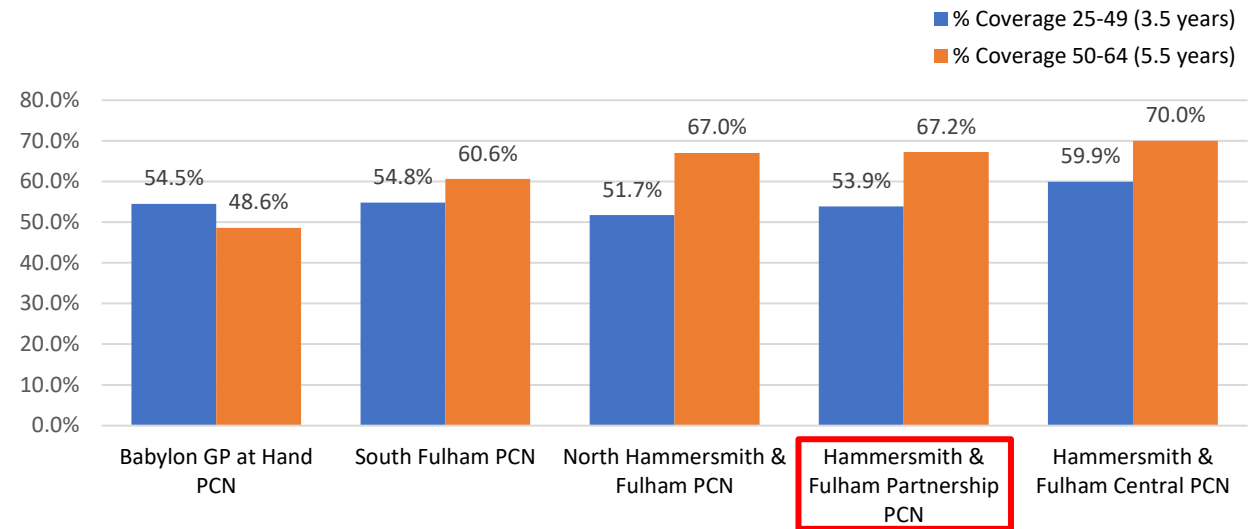

Cancer Screening: Cervical Cancer

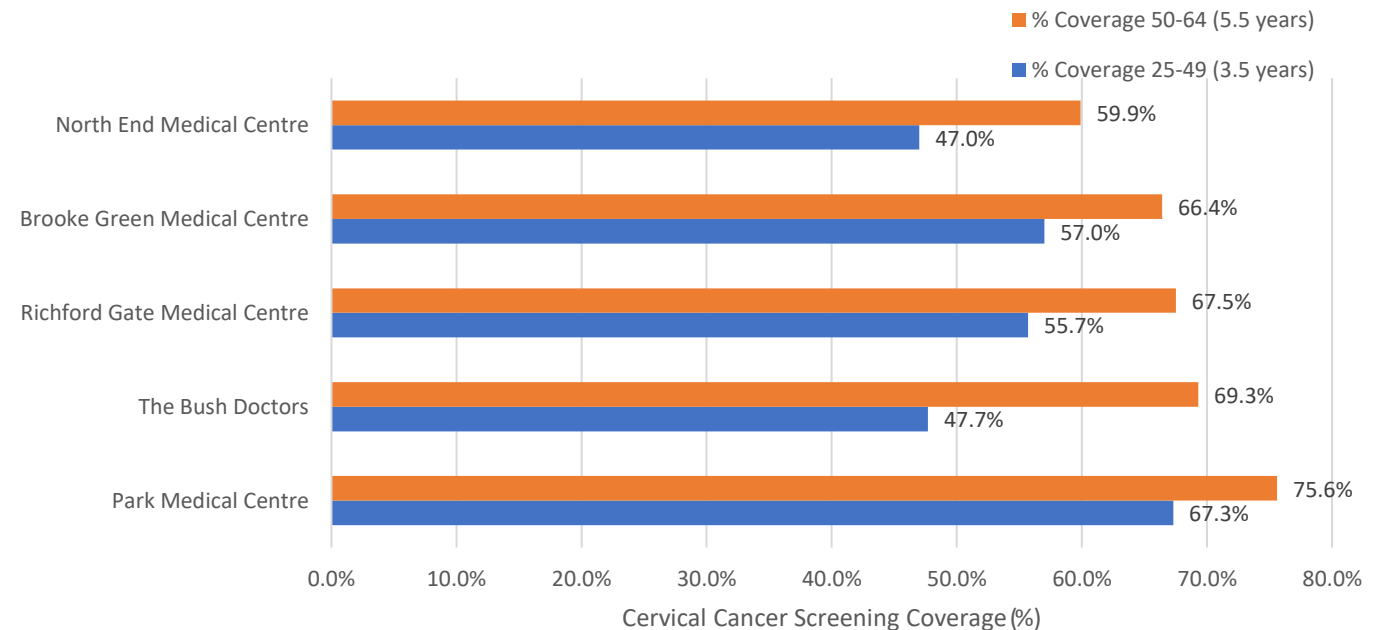
Section 3: Health Protection

- The coverage for cervical cancer screening amongst patients aged **25-49 years is lower compared to those aged 50-64 years** for all PCNs except for the Babylon GP at Hand PCN. **H&F Partnership PCN has the 2nd lowest** coverage rates amongst all PCNs for people aged 25-49 years (53.9%) and **2nd highest** for people aged 50-64 years (67.2%).
- **Park Medical Centre has the highest coverage for the 50-64 age group (75.6%) and the highest coverage amongst people aged 25-49 years (67.3%)** within H&F Partnership PCN.

Cervical cancer screening coverage in H&F Partnership PCN, 2021/22

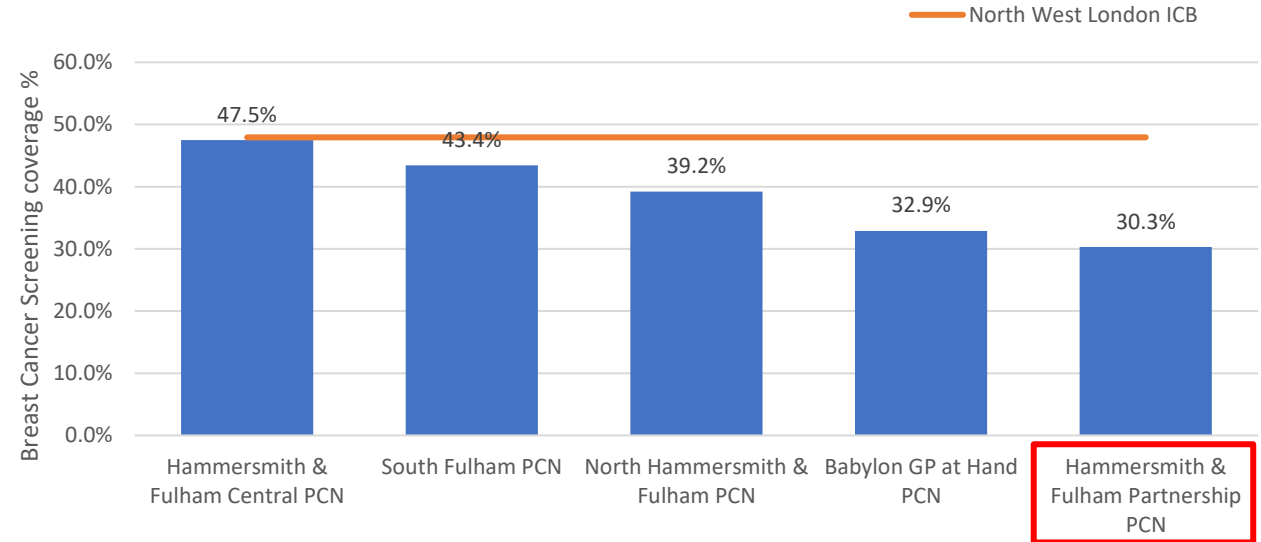


Cancer Screening: Breast Cancer

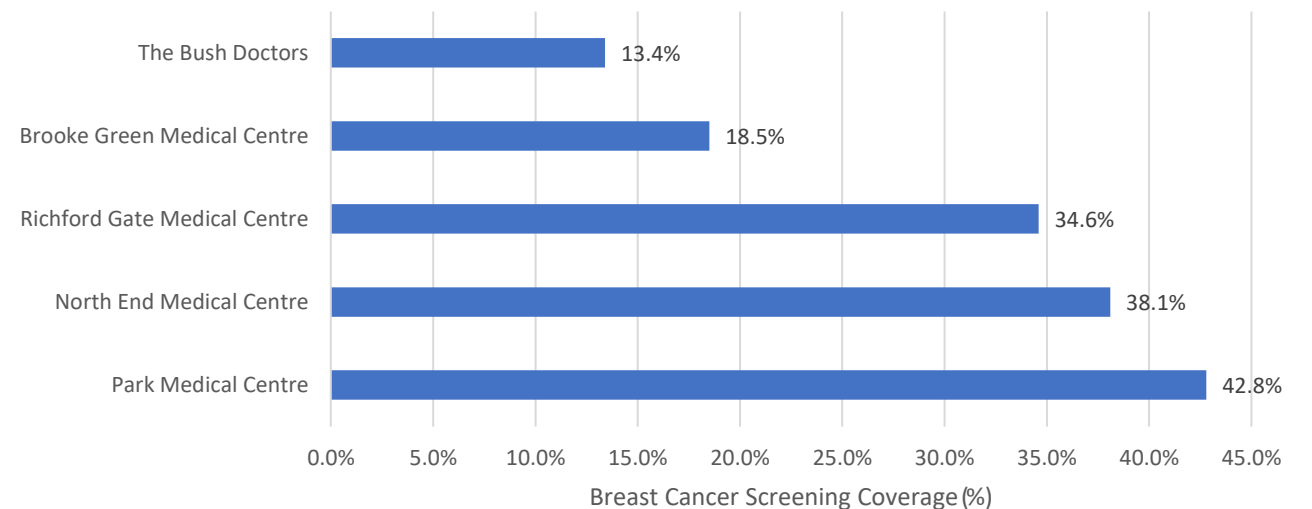
Section 3: Health Protection

- H&F Partnership PCN has the 1st lowest breast cancer screening coverage amongst all PCNs (30.3%). This is lower than the North West London ICB average of 47.9%.
- The **highest coverage** within H&F Partnership PCN has **Park Medical Centre (42.8%)** and the **lowest The Bush Doctors (13.4%)**.

Breast Cancer Screening Coverage by GP Practice, H&F Partnership PCN, 2021/22

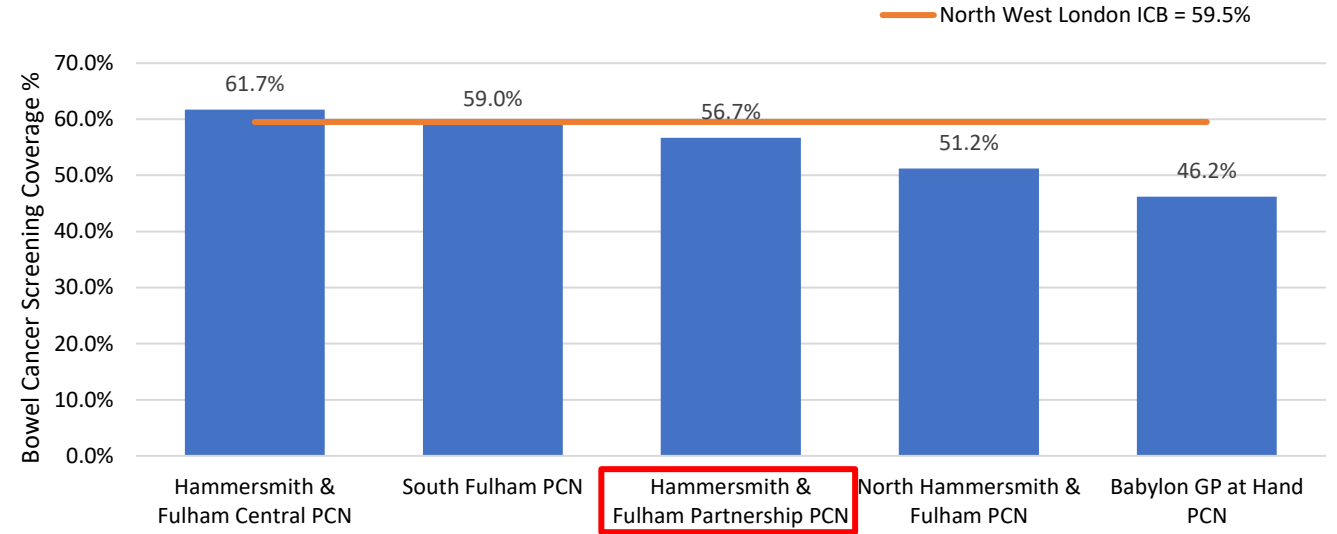


Cancer Screening: Bowel Cancer (aged 60 to 74 years old)

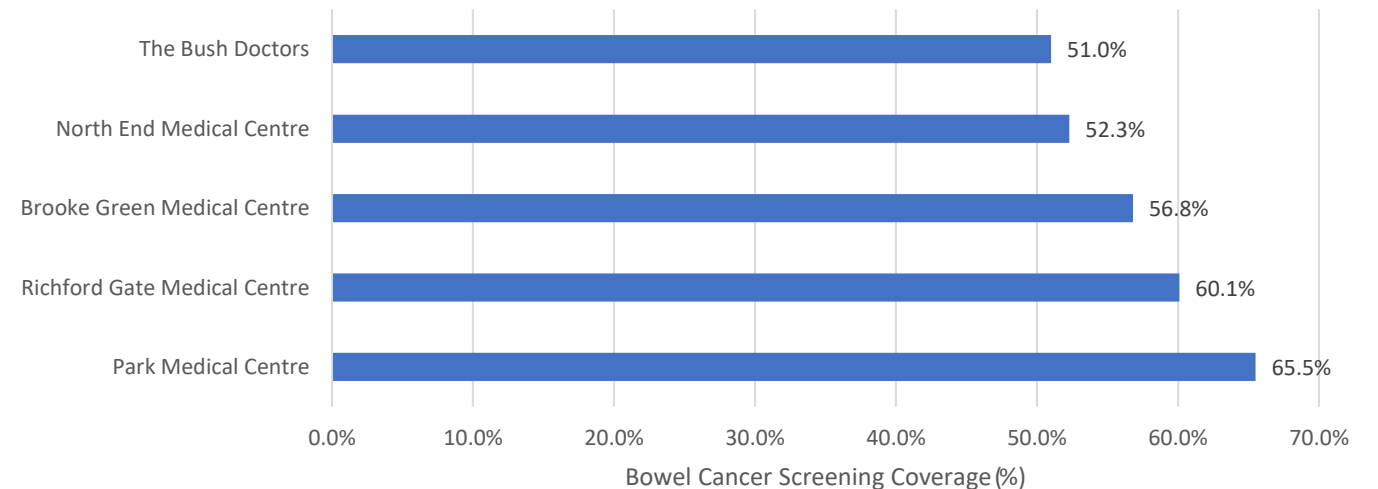
Section 3: Health Protection

- H&F Partnership PCN has the 3rd highest bowel cancer screening coverage amongst all PCNs (56.7%). This is lower than the North West ICB average of 59.5%.
- **Park Medical Centre** has the **highest coverage (65.5%)** within H&F Partnership PCN.

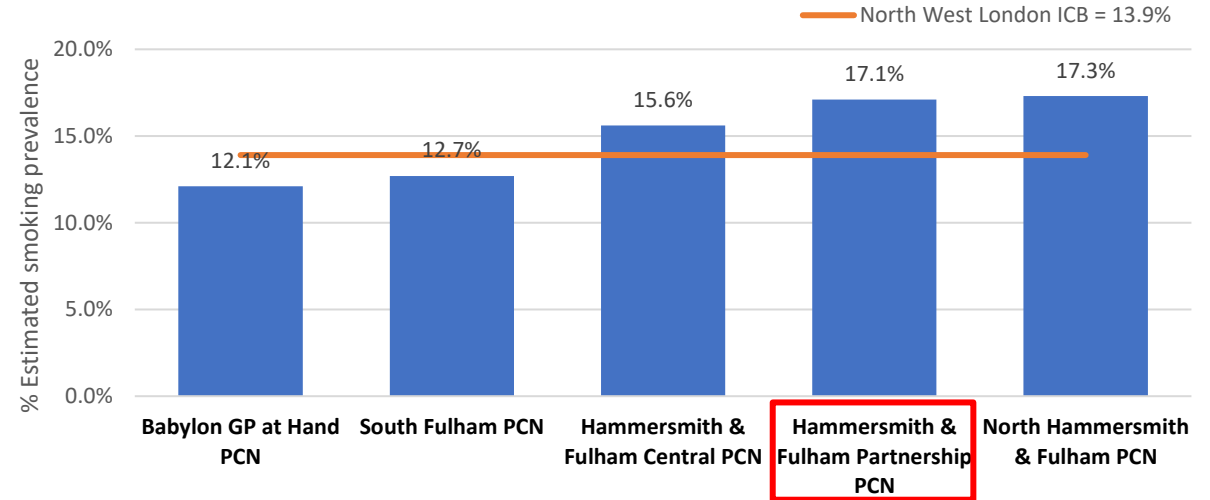

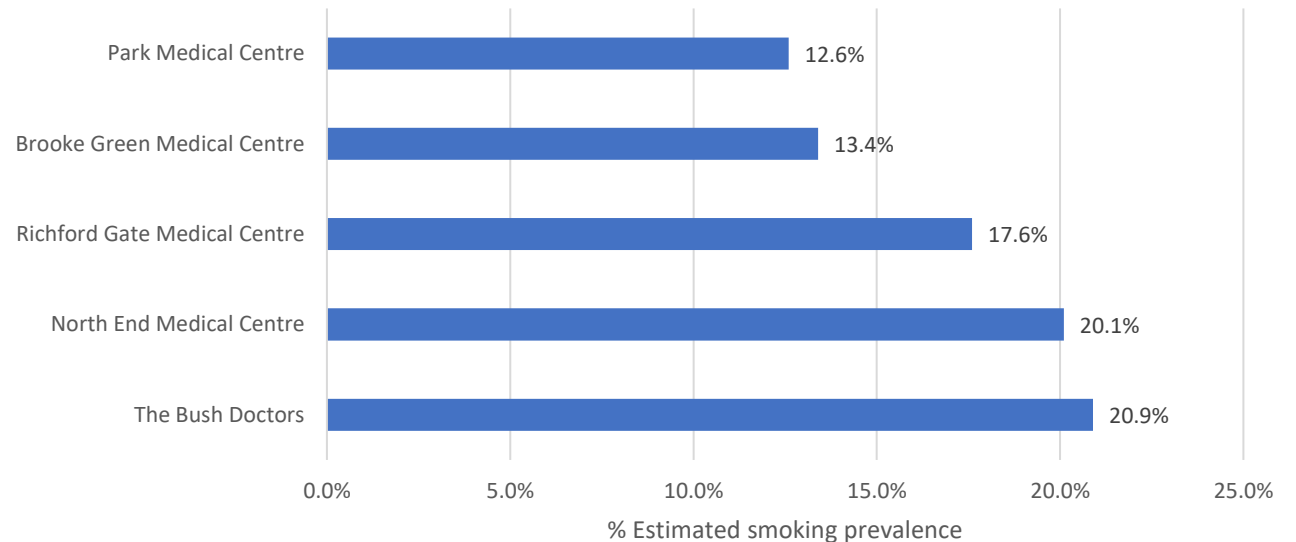
Section 4: Wider Determinants

- The estimated smoking prevalence amongst patients registered with H&F Partnership PCN is **17.1%**. This is higher than the NWL ICB figure of **13.9%**.
- Within H&F Partnership PCN, **The Bush Doctors** has the **highest** estimated smoking prevalence of **20.9%**.

Estimated smoking prevalence by GP practice, in H&F Partnership PCN in 2021/22

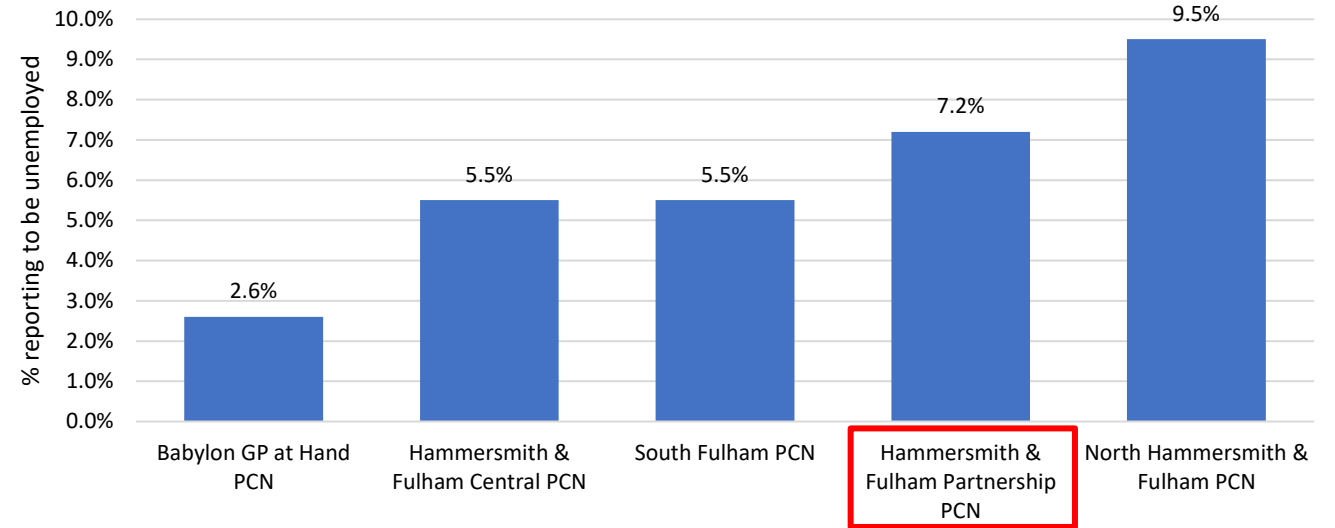

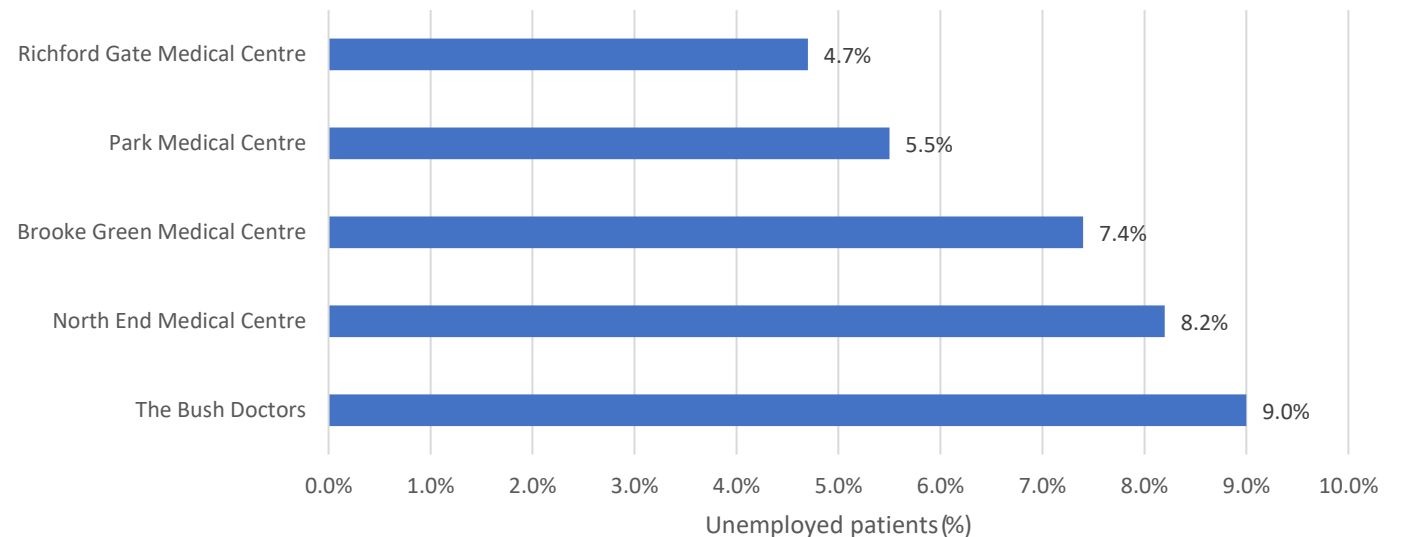
Section 4: Wider Determinants

- The percentage of patients reporting unemployment in H&F Partnership PCN is **7.2%**.
- Within H&F Partnership PCN, **The Bush Doctors** has the highest percentage of patients who reported being unemployed at **9.0%**.

Deprivation

Section 4: Wider Determinants

- IMD is a relative measure of deprivation. Decile 1 represents the most deprived 10% of neighbourhoods in England and decile 10 represents the least deprived 10% of neighbourhoods in England.
- H&F Partnership PCN has an average deprivation decile score of 4.2, which is the joint third most deprived PCN in the borough.
