




- Total of 63,179 patients registered at South Fulham PCN (October, 2023).

- There is more male (51.7%) than female (48.3%) patients registered.
- South Fulham PCN has a **larger older population above 45 years** compared to the overall H&F ICB population.

- 69% of the registered patients at South Fulham PCN are "White".
- 31% are from ethnic minority group.
- There is a higher proportion of White (13.3%) and Mixed (+0.5%) ethnicities when compared to the overall H&F population.
- Cassidy Medical Centre has the largest ethnic minority population (41%) compared to all other practices within South Fulham PCN.





% of patients with long term health conditions by GP practice, in South Fulham PCN in 2022




CHD Prevalence by GP practice, in South Fulham PCN in 2021/22





Diabetes prevalence by GP practice, in South Fulham PCN in 2021/22





Cancer prevalence by PCN, in H&F, 2021/22




Cancer prevalence by GP practice, in South Fulham PCN in 2021/22




- The coverage for cervical cancer screening amongst patients aged 25-49 years is lower compared to those aged 50-64 years for all PCNs except for the Babylon GP at Hand PCN.
- South Fulham PCN has one of the highest coverage rates amongst all PCNs for people aged 25-49 years but one of the lowest for people aged 50-64 years.
- The Fulham Medical Centre has the highest coverage for the 50-64 age group (65.0%) within South Fulham PCN.
- The Lilyville Surgery has the highest coverage amongst the 25-49 years age group (60.1%).

Cervical cancer screening coverage by GP Practice, in South Fulham PCN, 2021/22




Cancer Screening: Breast Cancer



Breast cancer screening coverage by GP Practice, in South Fulham PCN, 2021/22




Cancer Screening: Bowel Cancer (aged 60 to 74 years old)







Estimated smoking prevalence by PCN, in H&F, 2021/22




Estimated smoking prevalence by GP, in South Fulham PCN in 2021/22



Section 4: Wider Determinants

- IMD is a relative measure of deprivation. Decile 1 represents the most deprived 10% of neighbourhoods in England and decile 10 represents the least deprived 10% of neighbourhoods in England.
