Project Updates

Higgins have been progressing with works on the Aintree Estate. You may have seen the concrete frame being installed and the two new blocks taking shape.

In June 2024, we hosted members from the Residents' Steering Group (RSG) for a site visit, together with Hammersmith & Fulham Council's Development Engagement Manager.

The site tour was led by our Assistant Contract Surveyor, who gave the RSG a helpful update on the progress of works and explained a variety of methods that are used on site. The Higgins team answered residents' questions about the works, including explanations of methods used for the external and internal walls.

Naming the new blocks

The Aintree Estate Residents' Steering Group have narrowed down some potential names for the two new blocks, based on the online survey and in-person feedback received at the recent public project event.

Residents said they liked names that relate to the history of the local area and tell a story about the historic people and businesses that shaped Fulham.

Hammersmith & Fulham Council's street naming and numbering team will check the names with the Fire Brigade and Royal Mail. Once the final names are decided we will update the community.

Completed and Upcoming Works

Works carried out since May 2024

- Block A/B concrete frame progressing to level 3
- Block C concrete frame progressing to level 2
- Drainage working completed underneath the blocks
- Service and utility ducting is on-going

Upcoming Works

- Concrete frame works due for completion in October
- Metsec and window installation
- Scaffolding will start being erected.

Social Value and Community Engagement

June 2024:

Together with our Apprenticeship Training Provider, Joe Brennan Training (JBT), Higgins attended a Job Fair hosted by H&F Works.

We enjoyed meeting 150 local residents and gave them an overview about the Aintree Estate project. We informed them about the employment and training opportunities available on the project, including our Summer 2024 Work Experience Programme which is currently running.

July 2024:

Higgins supported days three and five of CYT's Year 10 'Work Experience World of Work Week Programme' which took place at Hammersmith Academy.

Our staff volunteers assisted two teams of six students with a project task related to the construction industry.

Each student had to take up the role of either an Architect, Design Manager, Engineer, Project Manager, Marketing Manager or Site Manager and complete various worksheets related to their chosen job role.

Higgins helped the students create a marketing campaign and on day five of the programme we supported the students with their projects and helped them prepare their presentations.

The students presented their projects to representatives from Queens Park Rangers Football Club and CYT's board team, who judged the two teams on various categories and selected a winner.

We were pleased to host two A-Level students from Phoenix Academy, Elias and Hassan, with two-day work experience placements based on the project at the beginning of July 2024.
