We are sending you this regular bulletin to keep you informed about upcoming works on the Aintree Estate construction site.

Recently completed works:

- Concrete frame block C
- Concrete frame block AB up to level 6

Upcoming works:

- External perimetral wall enclosures with metal frame and gypsum boards
- Scaffold installation
- Brickwork cladding

Information regarding crane lights

The cranes have a green light on at all times as part of their anti-collision system. This is a built in mechanism to prevent the crane colliding with another object. The green LED on a crane's anti-collision system indicates that the sensor is powered on which is a requirement.

The red light at the top of the crane is an aviation light which is required to remain on at all times. Aviation lighting is required by law for cranes that are in the catchment area or near a licensed aerodrome. The building site is situated inside the catchment area of London Helipad.

Requirements for aviation lighting on cranes include:

- **Location:** The lights must be mounted as close to the top of the crane as possible, and at intermediate levels spaced out equally between the top and ground.
- **Colour:** The lights must be steady red.
- **Visibility:** The lights must be visible from all directions at night.
